One inch of rain fall on a 1,000 foot surface will yield approximately 500 gallons of soft, untreated rain water, which is cost free and carbon neutral. So, save money, chemicals, water and energy by harvesting rain water with one or more of our 55 gallon rain barrels. In the process, support Natural Biodiversity's land restoration!
